TO ALL MUNICIPAL CLERKS AND BUILDING INSPECTORS

Please take note that on October 11, 1990, by Order-in-Council 90-833, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, under the Metric Conversion Act, adopted the National Building Code of Canada, 1990 edition, to be the construction standard in effect throughout the entire Province of New Brunswick, including all Municipalities.

Thus, regardless of what National Building Code is referenced in your Municipality's Building By-law, the 1990 National Building Code is in effect. You may wish to review your Building By-law, and amend it to adopt this new Code to make sure that there is no confusion by anyone wishing to build within your municipality.
