This project is designed to benefit our existing residents, future residents, tourists, businesses and potential business start-ups.

Weekly newsletter – the municipality has developed a weekly newsletter to amplify the upcoming projects, events, and initiatives in the community.

Tourism Marketing – the municipality showcases the community using different marketing tools including: Tourism NB, Day tripper, Explore NB, SJRVTA, etc.

Training & Mentoring

Mentorship – upon request the community will establish a mentorship team to assist new business start-ups with professional advice and guidance. This includes accounting, legal, graphic design, finance, etc.

Training & Education Opportunity – quarterly workshops will be offered to assist businesses with their training needs. Businesses will also receive information on upcoming training sessions being delivered through our partners (CBDC, BDC, Women in Business, etc.)
